Call for Book Proposals

The SBMAC SpringerBriefs series publishes relevant contributions in the fields of Applied Mathematics and Computational Sciences. Featuring compact volumes of 50 to 125 pages, the series covers a range of content from professional to academic.

This series welcomes the following types of submissions:

- An extended survey of an area
- An expansion and bridge between new research results, as published in journal articles
- A demonstration of core concepts that doctoral students must understand in order to make independent contributions
- Lecture notes making a specialized topic accessible to non-specialist
- A timely report of state-of-the art techniques
- An in-depth case study

Briefs are characterized by fast, global electronic dissemination, standard publishing contracts, standardized manuscript preparation and formatting guidelines, and expedited production schedules.

Your proposal must contain:

1. a) Title, b) authors, c) authors affiliations, d) e-mail addresses, e) corresponding author, f) key words, g) unique selling points (features and topics that distinguish your book from the others), h) competitive literature, i) a summary highlighting the core topics/concepts of the book and to whom it is intended to (for example, Doctoral Students initiating in Finance Mathematics, or Advanced undergraduate students and/or graduate students in the field of Mathematical Physics, or Control Theory, Mathematics of Aeronautics Sciences and Applications, etc.) and a table of contents. If you have part or the complete manuscript, please attach the PDF;
2. A biography/CV of the author(s);
3. Approximate submission date of the final manuscript;
4. For the manuscript preparation, Springer macros can be freely downloaded from <http://www.springer.com/authors/book+authors?SGWID=0-154102-12-417900-0>

Kindly submit your proposal at your earliest convenience. We will give a reply stating if your proposal would be accepted or not within six weeks, after receipt.

We need to plan in advance with Springer the number of manuscripts we intend to publish each year. We are continuously receiving your monograph proposals. Those willing to publish their manuscripts in 2015, please send your proposal by the end of October 2014.
