#### SCOPE:

The *International Conference in Energy and Sustainability in Small Developing Economies (ES2DE)* is an interdisciplinary conference held together with the *International Conference on Biomedical Engineering and Applications (ICBEA)* and the *International Conference on Mathematical Applications (ICMA)*, fostering the development and diffusion of knowledge regarding Energy and Sustainability with different approaches such as Machine Learning (in ICBEA) and Mathematical approaches (in ICMA) and in a more global way (in ES2DE).

## SUBMISSION DETAILS:

We invite the contributors to submit manuscripts of the following types: extended versions of ES2DE papers, original full-length research articles, and original short communications. Extended versions of ES2DE papers must contain at least 30% new material.

All papers are refereed through a peer review process. All manuscripts must be prepared according to the journal publication guidelines which can be found on the website <http://www.springer.com/energy/journal/40974>. The paper page limit (strict) is 20 pages for extended and original full papers, and 12 pages for short communications. Papers that will not follow journal formatting will not be considered for review.
