

Guidelines for Authors of *Cosmic Research*

Authors should adhere to the following rules in submitting manuscripts to *Cosmic Research*: the length of the manuscript, including references and figure captions, should not exceed 20 typewritten pages. An electronic version of the manuscript should be e-mailed to kosmos@ifz.ru. The text of the manuscript should be prepared in Microsoft Word format; the PDF file of the manuscript should also be attached.

The manuscript must be accompanied by two copies of the [copyright transfer agreement](#).

The text should be typeset as follows: variables and physical quantities should be italicized. Mathematical functions (e.g., sin, cos, tan, max, log, etc.), symbols of chemical elements, and Greek letters should be typeset in plain letters; vectors should be given in bold face. The names of spacecrafts should be italicized.

All tables, the list of references, and figure captions should be on separate pages. After the manuscript title, the list of authors, their affiliations, and e-mail addresses should be indicated.

Figures should be in the minimum acceptable size and placed on separate pages.

The abstract should contain the main results reported in the manuscript rather than a list of issues addressed; the title of the manuscript should not be repeated in the abstract. It is recommended not to introduce nonstandard abbreviations and references to the abstract. Overloading of the manuscript with formulas, duplicating the results in tables and figures, and repeating the text in the figure captions are not allowed. It is recommended to use, whenever possible, a slash sign for a fraction. Use a period, not a comma, for decimals.

Dates should be written in the following format: November 1, 2015; time is given in 24-h format, i.e., 13:10.

If a copyrighted material from other publications is used taken, the source should be cited and permission for its reproduction should be received.

The phone number and e-mail address of the corresponding author should be specified.
